## Nurse's Nook

Hand washing is the simplest and most effective way to prevent the spread of illnesses and infections. To properly wash your hands use clean, warm water and apply soap. Rub hands together vigorously to lather the soap into bubbles. This needs to be done for at least 20 seconds. Then rinse hands well under running water and dry hands. Hand washing should be implemented before preparing food, eating, after using the restroom, after blowing your nose, coughing, sneezing, after handling garbage, and before and after administering wound care.
