Prevention Services

<u>Family Education</u> programs teach the skills necessary to be the best parent possible.

<u>School-Based Prevention</u> programs teach a wide-range of social skills that promote positive youth development.

<u>Suicide Prevention</u> programs increase awareness about the signs of suicide and what to do if these signs exist.

School-based therapeutic day treatment services teach and reinforce appropriate social skills and behaviors, such as problem solving, anger management, community responsibility, increased impulse control, and appropriate peer relations, and may reduce the risk of more restrictive educational placements or out-of-home placements, such as hospitalizations.
